COMPETITION INFORMATION

THE COMPETITION

The British Diving Junior Elites is the highlight of the domestic junior calendar with the top divers aged under 18 battling it out for honours in their respective age groups 13 and under, 14 & 15 years and 16, 17 and 18 years, also known as C,B and A.

The Junior Elites not only serves to find our National Junior Elite Champions but more importantly it is the event used to select our Junior International Teams. In 2012 Olympic year the programme has been altered and the Junior Elites brought forward to April. This is a break in tradition going back well over twenty years, the rationale for this move was to free up the June week for the GB Championships and trials for the Olympic Games.

In 2012 divers in Plymouth will be aiming to qualify to compete in the International Junior Competition in Dresden Germany. The event is highly prestigious with 22 countries including China, Canada and Ukraine competing in 2011. The British Team divers will not only be competing for medals in Germany but also places in the European Junior Championship Team. With up to four GB divers per event only the top two achieving the qualifying standard in Germany will go to Gratz in Austria in July 2012

The Life Centre has a state of the art diving facility which is home to Thomas Daley 2009 World Champion and Tonia Couch Olympic and World Finalist.

The diving pool contains 4 x 1m springboard, 3 x 3m springboard including water harness, 3m wide platforms at 3m, 5m, 7.5m and 10m with 1.5m wide 1m platform. Bubble machines and Tivo systems. The dry dive gym has 3 x dry boards including foam pit 2 x trampoline, sprung floor, and general diving aids,

Any person wishing to apply for a coach / chaperone pass must have a valid CRB check through The ASA. Please read details on the application form carefully.

DIVE SHEETS

Divers/Coaches are requested to submit dive sheets electronically, both for their own convenience and to minimize the chance of errors loading the data into the Recording program. Coaches may make bulk submission of dive sheets on behalf of their divers by using the program DiveSheets with which they will already be familiar. Alternatively, individual divers may submit their own dive sheets on-line. Please agree with your coach which method you should use.

To submit your dive sheets on-line: www.diverecorder.co.uk/online sheets and follow the instructions. As soon as you complete the on-line submission you will see a success/failure message. If successful you will be sent an automatic email confirming receipt of your details and dives.

You can check your submitted dive sheets a few days before the event online at www.diverecorder.co.uk/live. If you experience problems and need assistance please contact Malcolm Taylor at malcolm@mdt.me.uk.

Electronic submissions must be made by no later than Midnight 2nd April 2012. You will be asked to sign hard copies of these sheets at the venue, available from the Recorders. If neither you nor your Coach are able to use the above electronic methods, you can submit a hard copy of your lists of dives to the Recorders.

Deadline for manual dive sheets is the Technical Meeting.

ASA REGISTRATION / MEMBERSHIP DEADLINE

Divers should be registered with the ASA 60 days prior to the commencement of the National Event ("The Meet") for which the diver is entering.

Divers must have been registered with the ASA / British Diving since Wednesday **8th February 2012**, or earlier.

International divers must be a member of their country's Diving Federation in order to enter.

The 9-13 3m synchro competition shall comprise five (5) dives; three (3) rounds of dives with an assigned degree of difficulty of 2.0 for each dive regardless of formula and two (2) rounds of dives without limit of degree of difficulty. The five (5) dives must be selected from at least three (3) different groups.

The 14-18 3m synchro competition shall comprise five (5) rounds of dives; two (2) rounds of dives with an assigned degree of difficulty of 2.0 for each dive regardless of formula and three (3) rounds of dives without limit of degree of difficulty. The five (5) dives must be selected from at least three (3) different groups.

Both synchro competitions – clarification:-

All forward facing dives shall be done with a running approach. No group may be used more than twice.

In each round the two divers must perform the same dive (same dive number and the same position).

Format for Elite Junior Nationals:-

- Age Group A, B and C divers will perform their full list of dives in the preliminary. The top six (6) British divers will proceed to the final. A maximum of six (6) guest divers, but no more than two (2) per team/country, whose scores are equal to or better than the sixth placed British diver will also proceed to the final. If there are less than 6 British divers then a maximum of 6 guest divers, but no more than two per team/country, will progress to the final. In the final the divers will repeat their optional dives, competing in the reverse order of their preliminary rankings, and the final result will be determined by adding their score from the final to that of the required dives total from the preliminary.
- Age Group categories and limits refer to the age of the diver on 31st December in the year of competition
- Minimum age for competitors is 9 years on 31 December in the year of competition
- Synchronised events will be straight finals.

GB Diving Events – Competition Format/Regulations

(See also, General Conditions)

All dives of the same number shall be regarded as the same dive.

No dives shall be repeated in any one round.

Only dives in the FINA diving tables or pursuant with the FINA formula may be executed.

The diver and the diver's representative are responsible for the accuracy of the statement in their list and the statement of dives shall be signed by the diver and the diver's representative.

Medals shall be awarded in all GB Diving Championships and Competitions to the first three placed divers in each competition and where different, to the first three placed British divers (see General Conditions for definitions of British).

Please consider the following clauses carefully when selecting events for your divers.

ELIGIBILITY

Please refer to the ASA Rules.

If a diver competes in the GB Senior Championships in any event (including synchro), they become permanently ineligible for the ASA National Age Group Competitions.

To dive Synchro at any GB event, both members of the pair must be diving at least 1 individual event at that Meet.

*Qualification Scores are set by a National Technical Panel and reviewed annually. All scores continue to be recommended scores for 2012, however it is strongly advised that all coaches encourage their divers to achieve their required score at one or more of the events below.

>>Regional event

>>Last year's National event (as long as they remain in the same age group)

Coaches fielding divers considered by British Diving Managers to be competing at the wrong level, will be approached by one of the British Diving's Managers and given advice on competition selection.

DEFINITIONS

Competing/competed. Divers are considered to be competing or to have competed at a certain level if they entered the contest – even if they did not dive due to injury or illness.

For example, if a diver was entered for the GB Senior Championships, but did not dive due to injury they cannot compete at the ASA National Age Groups

HOW TO ENTER

All entries for the British Gas Elite Junior Diving Championships must be made through the entry form at the back of this entry pack.

Please ensure that sufficient time is allowed for entries to reach the office within the deadline stipulated. We recommend that you send your entry via **special delivery** to ensure receipt.

Applicants are advised the CRB process could take up to 3 months to complete. Forms can be obtained through the ASA CRB Office on 01509 640738. All applicants must be registered with a club. The ASA will not be processing CRB Enhanced Disclosure Certificates issued by other registered / umbrella body organisations from 1st January 2008.

The ASA have endeavoured to offer a portability service but this has been increasingly difficult due to the withdrawal of support from other registered bodies, who will not share information they have received with The ASA. Accordingly and with regret this service has been withdrawn.

All ASA clubs and license applicants will have to complete a CRB application form regardless of any previous enhanced disclosure they have with another organisation, however recent. Further information on the CRB guidelines on portability is available on their website at www.crb.gov.uk.

First time applicants must complete both the CRB form and Self Declaration form (purple). The purple form will allow an individual to appear on the club's child protection list whilst the CRB application is being processed. The purple form gives the applicant the opportunity to declare any convictions that may appear on their disclosure. Forms are obtainable from the ASA CRB Office (01509 640738).
