

Terms and Conditions of entry

1. The promoter is British Swimming Supporters Club. (Hereinafter referred to as “we” or “our”)
2. The closing date for the competition is Friday 1st October 2010, at 5pm. Entries received after this time will not be considered. We do not accept responsibility for any lost, delayed, and incomplete entries or, for any other reason, entries not received or entries that cannot be entered for technical reasons. Proof of delivery of the entry is not proof of receipt.
3. The recipient of ‘the prize’ - four tickets to the Kellogg’s ASA Swimtastic Awards on November 20th 2010 (including the Swim with the Stars session and an overnight hotel stay), a Speedo LZR Racer signed by double Olympic champion Rebecca Adlington and a British Swimming Supporters Club hoodie, T-shirt and polo shirt (together ‘the prize’) - will be identified on the 30 October 2010 in accordance with paragraph 8 below – the individual with the highest points tally.
4. The CWG Dream Team is only open to British Swimming Supporters Club members, both standard and deluxe.
5. Individuals are entered by emailing their selected team to supporters@swimming.org or posting their entry to the address stated in paragraph 9. Together with their team the individuals are required to state their name, address, DoB and email for verification and communication purposes. By entering, all entrants agree to abide by each and all of these terms and conditions. Misrepresentative or fraudulent entries will invalidate an entry. We reserve the right to exclude entrants and withhold the prize for violating any of these terms and conditions. We reserve the right to modify, discontinue, temporarily or permanently, the opportunity to receive the prize with or without prior notice due to reasons outside our control or to amend or modify these terms and conditions at any time.
6. The recipient of the prize will be notified by post and email. Notification will be sent to the individual who formally entered in accordance with paragraph 5. All reasonable endeavours will be made to contact the individual with the highest points tally. If the individual cannot be contacted or is not available for the prize we reserve the right to identify the next individual with the highest points tally. No correspondence will be entered into with any entered individual except with the winner.
7. There is no cash or other alternative to the prize. The prize is not transferable or capable of being substituted.
8. By ‘highest points tally’ we mean the highest number of points achieved from the individuals submitted dream team in accordance with the specified points system on the entry information. In the event of a tie the winner will be determined by a count back – the number of gold medals, the number of silver medals, the number of bronze medals etc; through to the number of 8th places if required.
