

Field of Play Marshall

Role Objectives:

To assist the Field of Play Team in marshalling a variety of locations on deck.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Possible marshal locations include, but are not limited to:
- Call room - ensure all competitors report to marshalling and call room area prior to each event on time.
- Refreshments – ensure officials, field of play team members, coaches and athletes have topped up refreshments during competition.
- Warm up - ensure all training and warm-up procedures are followed to maintain the safety of athletes, as well as training sessions run to time. Assisting the Field of Play Team in clearing the pool at the end of warm up.
- Assemble competitors into correct lane order prior to walk-on for each event. The order is determined by the FOP Manager as appropriate for each event.
- Escort competitors to the next call room or holding area and onto the deck at the appropriate time.
- Support the Technical Officials in the call room with any suit and advertising check requirements.
