

Swim England London Region Open Diving Skills Competition 2022

Dear Diving Clubs,

You are invited to the Swim England London Region 'Open' Diving Skills Competition 2022 to be held at the London Aquatics Centre, Queen Elizabeth Olympic Park, Stratford E20 2ZQ on Saturday 16th April from 11am.

This is a Level 2 diving competition where competitors have the opportunity to try and reach their qualification standard for this year's National Skills Finals to be held at the John Charles Centre for Sport in Leeds on Saturday the 9th and Sunday the 10th July.

The conditions are on the following pages and incorporate any changes introduced for this year's National Skills Finals. Please read carefully and contact me if you have any questions.

The competition will feature the following events for girls and boys: Group E (8/9 years), Group D1 (10 years), Group D2 (11 years), Group C1 (12 years), Group C2 (13 years) and Group B+ (14/16 years). Subject to space, there is no restriction on the number of entries per club. The top two divers from each London club in each event will earn points towards the George Rackham Team Trophy.

The entry fee is £15 per diver and the entry closing date is Tuesday 5th April. Subject to space, late entries may be accepted at the organisers' discretion at £30 each. Clubs attending are required to provide competent judges to ensure the meet runs fairly and smoothly. Guidance on judging this competition will be given at the technical meeting before the meet starts. Dive sheets must be entered on DiveRecorder by 2pm on Friday 15th April.

Medals and an Easter egg will be awarded to the top three girls and boys in each event. As this is an open event there is only one set of awards/results. There are no separate, individual medals for London and other regions' clubs.

Group C – Optional Dives

Forward and reverse dives are to be performed with either a standing T-start armswing OR a 2-bounce start OR with a hurdle step.

All back take-offs are to be performed with a T-start armswing.

Inward dives may be performed starting with the arms above the head (no armswing) OR a T-start armswing.

Group B+ – Optional Dives

Forward and reverse dives are to be performed with either a standing T-start armswing OR a 2-bounce start OR with a hurdle step.

All back take-offs are to be performed with a T-start armswing.

Inward dives may be performed starting with the arms above the head (no armswing) OR a T-start armswing.

*Dives of the same number are considered to be repeats, even if they are in a different shape.

E, D and C are run in a “circuit” format with groups of competitors simultaneously competing on 1m, 3m and poolside, enabling 12 skills to be completed in the same amount of time as 4.

B+ is run in a “circuit” format with groups of competitors simultaneously competing on 1m and 3m, enabling 10 dives to be completed in the same amount of time as 5.

The winner is the diver with the highest combined points total from ALL stations added together.

Entry Form

Entry Fees

The entry fee is £15 per diver and should be paid at the time of entry. Note that late entries at £30 per diver may be accepted – but only if there is enough space (*organisers’ decision is final on this matter*). Divers will be withdrawn 30 minutes before the start of their event if their fees have not been paid beforehand. All payments should be made by BACS transfer using the following details:

Dive Sheets

All dive sheets must be submitted via DiveRecorder by 2pm on Friday 15th April. Dive sheet changes will be allowed up to an hour before the start of each session. Mini dive sheets will be available at poolside on the day to be signed by either divers or coaches.

The Competition

The meet will be run under Swim England Regulations and the FINA Technical Rules of Diving.

Eligibility / Ineligibility

Divers must be Swim England 'Category 2' registered (Club Compete) to compete. Once a diver has competed at the National Age Group Championships they are ineligible at future National Skills Finals, except with prior written approval from the Swim England Diving Leadership Group when moving into Group B+. Swim England Team Z divers are ineligible. Divers must achieve the qualification standard at a regional skills qualifier in the same year as the National Skills Finals. Divers who have competed at regional age groups are ineligible to compete at the National Skills Finals in the same year.

National Skills Finals Qualification Standards

Please see the conditions above for this year's National Skills Finals qualification standards.

Timetable / Training

A provisional timetable will be circulated after the entry closing date.

Technical Meeting

A brief technical meeting for all coaches and clubs will be held on poolside before the start of the first session. We ask that each club is represented.

Judging

Each club must provide at least one qualified J1 judge. All stations will run with 3 or 5 judges. A judging rota will be compiled at the competition. We want to be flexible with the judging allocation, so if you wish to swap with another club then that is acceptable – but only if you can find someone competent to swap with. Please note that the London Region judge selection for the National Skills Finals will be made from the judges at this regional qualifier.

Discretion

The chief referee's decision will be final on any decisions regarding queries, discrepancies or protests specific to this meet. As this is a Level 2 competition we will try to be lenient and err on the side of the divers when taking decisions.

Results and Presentations

Due to time constraints there will be no diver parades. Results will be announced in reverse order and medals presented directly after each session. Please remind divers to wear their club kit when receiving their medals. The awards will be presented by a dignitary representing London Region or the winning diver's coach.

The London Team Trophy

The top two divers from each London club, finishing in the top 12 in each event, shall score points towards the team trophy.

Team points shall be awarded as follows: 1st – 20 points; 2nd – 15 points; 3rd – 12 points; 4th – 10 points; 5th – 8 points; 6th – 7 points; 7th – 6 points; 8th – 5 points; 9th – 4 points; 10th – 3 points; 11th – 2 points; 12th – 1 point.
