Entry Process

Membership*

Competitors must be Swim England *Club Compete* category members (previously titled *Category 2*) or equivalent. Competitors who do not hold current nor correct membership category will not be available for selection within the entry system.

*PLEASE NOTE: If a competitor needs registering as a new *Club Compete* member or needs upgrading, and their membership needs processing (to allow them to enter the Championships) prior to the club completing their renewals batch with the Membership team, the club will need to make the necessary amendments via the Online Membership System and then complete the Fast Track Membership form:

Uploading an accreditation photo

All competitors are required to upload a photo of themselves for accreditation purposes before an entry can be submitted.

Photos should be uploaded via the **BIOGS PAGE**.

- The photo should be a clear head and shoulders shot
- Photo size width should be cropped to 200 pixels
- See the <u>Updating Biogs or Uploading a photograph Guidance Document</u> for further instructions

If the photo is deemed to be unsuitable (either on the grounds of poor quality or wrong identity) entry into the event may not be permitted.

Grade Level

The required **Routine** and **Figure** Grade Levels are detailed in the Event Conditions (see *Conditions*, p.13). A competitor's **Routine** and **Figure** Grade Level can be viewed online via the Membership Check (see *Membership* section, p.4).

Youth Category Upper Age Limits

All online entries submitted as part of the Championships are bound by the event conditions. Clause 4 (p.14) of the Championships Conditions outlines the upper age limits which differ for male (16 years) and female (15 years) athletes in the Youth Category.

Due to the recent introduction of a number of new rules and the system changes required to meet the new updates, the entry system does not currently differentiate the bespoke upper age limits required between female and male athletes in the Mixed Duet and Team events in the Youth Category. The entry system upper age limit has been set to 16 years to enable male athletes to appear for selection. Female athletes who are 16 years may appear in the drop down list for selection for Youth events, but please note that their selection would be in breach of the Championships conditions. Please select athletes as per the stated upper age limit outlined in the Championships conditions.



Anti-Doping

Whether by accident or on purpose, doping is against the rules of the sport. Swim England and British Swimming promote a culture of doping-free sport. Competitors are advised that Anti-Doping control may take place during this event.

Please ensure competitors keep their accreditation on person at all times, as this will be used for identification. For further information, please refer to Anti-Doping section: https://www.swimming.org/swimengland/anti-doping/

Please note that in accordance with the International Standards for Testing, it is the competitor's responsibility to provide all information and dosage for any medications and supplements taken on the doping control form, at the point of doping control.

Strict liability means competitors are responsible for any banned substance found in their system, no matter how it got there.

Accreditation

Accreditation must be worn at all times inside the venue within accredited areas. Accreditation will be issued on an individual and event basis, and is non-transferrable.

Competitors

Competitor accreditation will be sent in a confirmation email on completion of the entry and will be sent to the email address provided at the time of entry.

The following guidelines should be followed to ensure the competitor accreditation is correct:

- Competitor accreditation must be printed in advance and brought to the event;
- Once printed, the accreditation should be folded twice so that the photo is visible on the front and back;
- At the event, lanyards and accreditations pouches will be available from collection points.

A £10 charge will be applied to replace any lost or forgotten accreditations.

Accreditation checks will be carried out at the event and entry into the event may be denied without the accreditation pass.

Coaches, Team Managers and Chaperones

Poolside Accreditation Pass Charge £10

Coaches, team managers and chaperones requiring access to poolside must purchase a Poolside Accreditation pass in advance of the event and must fulfil the following criteria, as required by their role, when applying for a pass to attend any Swim England National events:

- 1. DBS: valid Disclosure and Barring Service check (DBS)
- 2. Minimum Qualification/Requirements (specific to the role):
 - a. Coaches Coaching Qualification or Assistant Coach Certificate
 - b. Team Manager Team Manager Training Module 1 Certificate
 - c. Chaperone Club authorisation to be acting in loco parentis on behalf of the Club
- 3. Safeguarding Certificate: valid Safeguarding certificate updated and recorded with Swim England Membership Department.



Event Conditions

1. General Conditions

- 1.1. The Artistic Swimming Leadership Group ("the Group") reserves full powers over the Swim England Artistic Swimming National Age Group Championships ("the Championships"), including but not limited to cancelling, postponing or changing the Championships venue and/or format due to reasons beyond its reasonable control.
- 1.2. The Championships shall be competed for annually, under World Aquatics (formerly FINA) Technical Rules of Artistic Swimming (701 et seq) and as provided by the following conditions. Where World Aquatics Rules do not provide (for example: Health and Safety Regulations and guidelines and Child Safeguarding), the requirements of Swim England shall apply.
- 1.3. Entries will only be accepted from:
 - 1.3.1. Competitors registered as members of Swim England.
 - 1.3.2. Competitors from Scottish Swimming, Swim Wales and countries affiliated to World Aquatics.
- 1.4. The promotion of the Championships shall be the responsibility of the Group, which shall for all purposes be regarded as the Promoter. It shall decide any matter arising that is not covered by these conditions, subject to conformity with Swim England Regulations.
- 1.5. The date and venue of the Championships shall be decided by the Group.
- 1.6. A competitor must have been a registered member, or equivalent, of the club in whose name she/he is entered, at least 60 days prior to the first day of the competition.
- 1.7. All Clubs must have a qualified Level 2 Artistic Swimming Coach on the poolside. The Coach must be in possession of an official event poolside accreditation pass.
- 1.8. Competitors must be Swim England Club Compete registered members or equivalent if competing under 1.3.2.

2. Officials

- 2.1. All officials shall be qualified and be on the Artistic Swimming Licensed Officials List (where applicable).
- 2.2. Additional Officials will be appointed from the Artistic Swimming Licensed Officials List (where applicable).
- 2.3. The Referee and Chief Recorder shall be approved by the Group.

3. Method of Entry

- 3.1. Online entry system contact National Events Department, Pavilion 3, SportPark, Oakwood Drive, Loughborough, Leicestershire, LE11 3QF.
- 3.2. Entries shall be submitted online to Swim England Events Department together with the appropriate entry fees, no later than the set closing deadline. An updated photograph of each competitor must be also submitted online.
- 3.3. A Coach Card must be submitted for each routine electronically prior to the competition (see Appendix 5). Routines without a submitted Coach Card by the published deadline will not be permitted to swim in the Championships.
- 3.4. If required, all music information must be registered with The Limited Manufacturing License, Mechanical-Copyright Protection Society (MCPS).
- 3.5. All music must be submitted for each routine electronically prior to the competition. Routines without submitted music prior to the published deadline will not be permitted to swim in the Championships.

4. Championship Events

- 4.1. Championships Figure Competition:
 - 4.1.1. 12 & Under Age Category:
 - 4.1.1.1. 9 10 Years Female and Male
 - 4.1.1.2. 11 12 Years Female and Male
 - 4.1.2. Youth Category:
 - 4.1.2.1. 13 15 Years Female
 - 4.1.2.2. 13 16 Years Male
- 4.2. Championship Routine Competition:
 - 4.2.1. 12 & Under Age Category: Solo, Duet, Mixed Duet, Free Team
 - 4.2.2. Youth Category: Solo, Duet, Mixed Duet, Free Team
 - 4.2.2.1. 13 15 Years Female
 - 4.2.2.2. 13 16 Years Male

5. Entry Qualifications for the Championships Events

- 5.1 All Competitors, wishing to compete in Solos, Duets, Mixed Duets and Teams must compete in the Figure competition.
- 5.2 Age as at midnight on the 31 December in the year of competition.
- 5.3 Competitors may only enter one solo, one duet, and one team
- 5.4 Male and/or female competitors with the appropriate minimum Grades (See Appendix1) are eligible to compete in the Solo, Duet, and Free Team
- 5.5 One Male and One Female competitor with the appropriate minimum Grades (see Appendix 1) are eligible to compete in the Mixed Duet
- 5.6 Qualifying Grades must have been attained 20 days prior to the closing date for the competition and be recorded in the competitors' membership record.
- 5.7 Clubs may enter one or more Free Team in each age group providing the first entry has the maximum competitors allowed. i.e. eight (8) competitors.
- 5.8 Competitors in the duet and free team must be members of the same club.

6 Figures

- 6.1 In the 12& Under Age Category, each competitor must perform four (4) figures: The two (2) compulsory figures and one (1) group of two (2) figures drawn from the list in Appendix 2
- 6.2 In the Youth category, each competitor must perform a group of four (4) from Section A, B or C. in Appendix 2
- 6.3 The order of appearance for figures shall be decided by random draw. The draw shall take place at least 24 hours before the first part of the competition.

7 Routines

- 7.1 In each Age Group category, up to twelve (12) of the highest placed competitors from the figure competition who hold the appropriate Grade levels, shall perform in the Solo events. This includes a maximum of 3 competitors from 1.3.2 and a minimum of 9 competitors from 1.3.1.
- 7.2 In each Age Group category, up to twelve (12) of the highest placed pairs from the figure competition with the appropriate Grade level shall compete in the Duet events. This includes a maximum of 3 competitors from 1.3.2 and a minimum of 9 competitors from 1.3.1
- 7.3 Competitors in the 9-10 years figure section will be eligible to compete in the 12&Under solo and duet events if their scores place them within the overall top twelve (12).
- 7.4 All Mixed Duets and Teams shall swim.
- 7.5 The order of appearance for routines in the Solo, Duet and Free Team events will be by container draw.
- 7.6 The order of appearance for Mixed Duets will be by random draw
- 7.7 A team shall consist of not less than four (4) or not more than eight (8), plus 2

- reserves, for Free Team routines.
- 7.8 The names of the competitors competing in the Duets and Free Teams must be submitted to the Referee, in writing, within one hour of the figure results being available. Changes after this time may only be made in the case of sudden illness or accident of the competitor, and if the reserve is ready to compete without delaying the event. If the lack of a reserve reduces the team size to less than four (4) in the Free Team the team shall be disqualified.
- 7.9 Failure to notify the Referee of substitution and/ or withdrawals shall result in disqualification.
- 7.10 Time limits for the routines will be according to Appendix 3.
- 7.11 The number of hybrids and acrobatics shall be performed in accordance to Appendix 4.

8 Scoring and Penalties

- 8.1 The judging scoring for this year's Championships will be based on World Aquatics Rules 2017-2022.
- 8.2 In all routines a two point penalty shall be deducted from the Execution score for each element exceeding or omitting from the predetermined number assigned to the particular event and category outlined in Appendix 4.

9 Trophies and Medals

- 9.1 Medals will be awarded to competitors who are placed first, second and third overall in each age group Figures, Solos, Duets, Mixed Duets and Free Team.
- 9.2 Medals will be awarded to highest placed competitors who are registered with Swim England clubs who are placed first, second and third in each age group in figures, solos and duets, only if different from the overall results in 8.1
- 9.3 For Solos, Duets, and Free Team, figure results will be added to the routine score up to a maximum of 200 points. For Mixed Duets the final result will be the total routine score up to a maximum of 100 points.
- 9.4 Only Clubs registered with Swim England will be eligible to receive a trophy listed in 9.4.1 -9.4.3
 - 9.4.1 The Richard Whitehead Trophy will be awarded to the club with the highest combined figure and routine score in the 12& U Age Group Free Team event.
 - 9.4.2 The Mrs Y M Price Trophy will be awarded to the club with the highest combined figure and routine score in the 13-15 Age Group Free Team event.
 - 9.4.3 The Shacklock Trophy will be awarded annually to the competitor, who is registered with a Swim England Club, with the highest total of routine scores without figures added, in the Solo, Duet and Free Team Championship events. The winner can be from any age group at these Championships.

10 Event Cancellation

- 10.1 In the instance that the event is cancelled:
 - 10.1.1 Full refunds of entry fees to the Championships will be offered to all competitors.
 - 10.1.2 No refunds will be offered for any other expenses incurred in relation to the Championships.
