

Swim England Senior Performance Squad (SPS)

Key consideration criteria

- Age 18+ years of age by 31 December 2023.
- Selections are at the absolute discretion of the Swim England Head of Talent.
- Up to 20 athletes.
- Swimmer that display excellent performance behaviours and skills and positive performance curve over the last two swimming seasons in the main event.
- Swimmers that have the potential to compete competitively for England at the Commonwealth Games Victoria 2026.
- Times used for selection to the SPS will be taken from the Swim England long course national rankings, and be achieved between 1 January 2023 and 16 August 2023.
- Priority will be given to performances at the following competitions in 2023:
 - British Para-Swimming International Meet.
 - British Swimming Championships.
 - British Summer Championships.
 - English National Summer Meet.
 - Commonwealth Youth Games.
- Up to four para-swimmers (included within the total of 20 swimmers) *see general conditions for more information.
- Selected Para-Swimmers must be eligible to represent England or Britain at future major international competitions.
- As a minimum, standard times will only be considered where they are in excess of the below World Aquatics Points (WAP)/British Para-Swimming Points (BPSP).
- Please note achieving these points does not guarantee selection to a talent programme:

Selections will be finalised after World Class Programme selections in October 2023

Athletes selected for world class podium and podium potential will not be eligible for selection.

Athletes that attend the British Swimming National Centres are not eligible for selection.
