

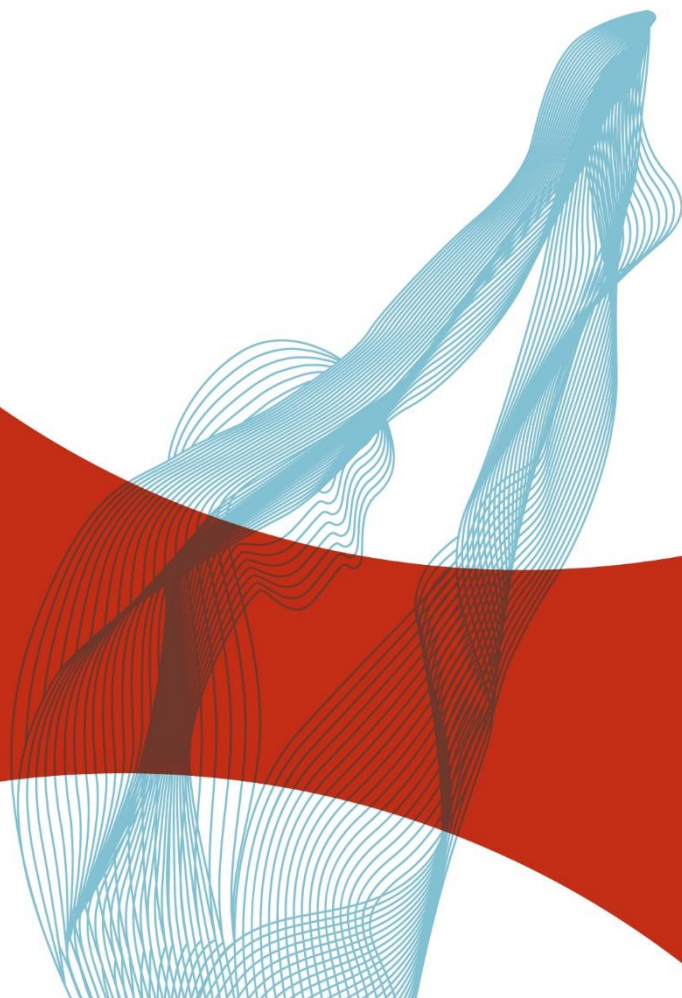

Dive Sheets

Competitors/Coaches are requested to submit dive sheets electronically, both for their own convenience and to minimise the chance of errors loading the data into the recording program. Coaches can make bulk submissions of dive sheets on behalf of their competitors by using the program *DiveSheets* with which they should already be familiar. Alternatively, individual competitors may submit their own dive sheets online. Coach and competitor should agree on which method should be used.

Dive sheets should be submitted online at www.diverecorder.co.uk. As soon as the dive sheet has been submitted a success or failure message will be displayed. If successful, an automatic email will be sent confirming receipt of the details and dives. Dive sheets can be checked, and amended, a few days before the event at www.diverecorder.co.uk/live. However, amendments must be done before the deadline passes. If a problem occurs, please contact francisco.diaz@btinternet.com

Electronic dive sheet submissions must be made no later than **18:00 on Wednesday 15 July 2026**.

At the event, the competitor or their coach must sign hard-copy dive sheets. Dive sheet packs will be available from the Recorders and also distributed at the Technical Meeting.

If the above electronic method is unable to be used, hard copy dive sheets can be submitted to the recorders at the event. The deadline for manual dive sheets is at **16:45 on Friday 17 July 2026**, which is 15 minutes before the start of the Technical Meeting.

Pool Training Schedule – Friday 17 July

On Friday 17 July, 45-minute training slots will be available for clubs to pre-book between 15:00 – 19:30 in the diving pit.

The cost is £10 per diver, to be paid to the South East Region. Click [here](#) to view availability and to book a slot.

Athlete and Coach Seating

Dedicated competitor and coach seating will be available in the main spectator seating near the recorders' table.

Key Protocols

- The use of mobile phones is not permitted in changing rooms.
- Please store bags and belongings in the changing room lockers or leave them with family members.
- Belongings brought into the venue are at the competitor and team staff's own risk. Swim England South East Region will not be responsible for any lost, stolen or damaged items.
- Please note there will be a clear deck policy.
- Competitors should only be poolside when they are training, competing, in a parade or in a medal ceremony.
- Adhere to the instruction of the Field of Play marshals when accessing poolside for warm-up or competition at all times.

Clothing

All competitors should be aware that no GB kit is to be worn at any point during the event. During medal ceremonies, full club kit or tracksuits must be worn and neither bare feet nor towels are allowed. Boards will be closed for presentations.



Accreditation

Athlete and team staff accreditation must be printed in advance and brought to the event and must be worn at all times inside the venue within accredited areas. Accreditation will be issued on an individual and event basis and is non-transferrable. Lanyards and accreditation pouches will be available at the event.

Competitors

Competitor accreditation will have been sent in the confirmation email received on completion of the entry and sent to the email address provided at the time of entry. If you need the accreditation resent to you, click [here](#) and do it in Entry Viewer.

Coaches, Team Managers and Chaperones

Clubs must follow the guidance as set out in the current version of [Wavepower](#).

*** NOTE: All coaches, including those who are judging, need to apply for a poolside accreditation. Coaches must wear their accreditation for booked training on Friday 17 July.**

To obtain an accreditation, coaches, team managers and chaperones must fulfil the following criteria, as required by their role, when applying to attend a Swim England national event:

- 1. DBS:** You must have a valid Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) with Barred List check.
- 2. Safeguarding Certificate:** All coaches, team managers and chaperones are required to have an approved and in date safeguarding certificate recorded with the Swim England membership department.
- 3. Minimum Qualification/Requirements (specific to the role):** Coaches must have a qualification in line with the Swim England [Coaching Policy](#). Team Managers must have the appropriate Team Manager module for the competition and Chaperones must only be in attendance on a 1:1 support basis for an athlete as per the [Team Manager, Coach and Chaperone Policy](#).

The following guidelines should be followed to ensure the competitor accreditation is correct:

- Competitor accreditation must be printed in advance and brought to the event.
- Once printed, the accreditation should be folded twice so that the photo is visible on the front and back.
- At the event, lanyards and accreditations pouches will be available from collection points for accreditation passes.

Lost or Forgotten Accreditation Passes

A £10 charge will be applied on all lost or forgotten passes if a competitor arrives at the event without their accreditation.

Accreditation checks will be carried out at the event and entry into the event may be denied without the accreditation pass.



Medical

Location of Defibrillator

The facility is equipped with automated external defibrillators (AED). All lifeguards and managers are trained on how to use them. They should only be used by someone who has received appropriate training.

By entering this event the athlete consents to report to Doping Control, if requested, at any time during this event and agrees to abide by the British Swimming Anti-Doping Rules (2021), which Swim England is signed up to.

If an athlete is tested through doping control at an event, they should ensure they provide detail of all medications (prescribed or over the counter and including dosage) and supplements taken within the last 7 days in advance of the test on the Doping Control Form. Any previously disclosed medications or supplements to the athlete's club and/or talent programme are still required to be included on the doping control form.

Medications

- Medication should be checked via Global DRO (see above).
- If the medication being taken is prohibited in or out of competition, a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) may be required.

Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE)

- If an athlete IS WITHIN the National TUE Pool they are required to obtain a TUE before using a prohibited medication or method. Athletes can check if they are within the National TUE Pool via UKAD website (see above) and by selecting 'aquatics'.
- If an athlete is NOT within the National TUE Pool but using a prohibited medication or method and is subject to doping control they are required to apply for a retroactive TUE as soon as possible after doping control. A retroactive TUE must be submitted to UKAD (UK Anti-Doping) within five (5) working days of the testing taking place.

All athletes are subject to 'Strict Liability' which means an athlete is wholly responsible for any banned substance found in their system, no matter how it got there.
